Capital Network System, Inc., a Texas corporation, has requested permission from the Department of Public Utilities to provide alternative operator services to customers in Massachusetts.

This investigation is officially captioned:

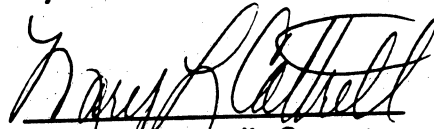
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Application of Capital Network System, Inc., under the provisions of Chapter 159 of the General Laws, as amended, for a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a resale, value-added or interexchange common carrier within the Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

Comments, objections and requests for a public hearing on the proposed service must be made in writing with specific reasons for requesting a public hearing, and filed with the Secretary of the Department on or before March 14, 1994.

The petitioner, Capital Network System, Inc., is required to complete the following: (1) Give notice by publication hereof once, on or before February 21, 1994 [which is twenty-one (21) days prior to March 14, 1994], in the Boston Globe, the Morning Union (Springfield), the Berkshire Eagle (Pittsfield) and the Worcester Telegram; (2) Give notice by mailing a copy hereof on or before February 11, 1994 to the Local Exchange and Other Common Carriers on the attached Interexchange Carriers list; and (3) Make return of service and publication no later than March 28, 1994.
