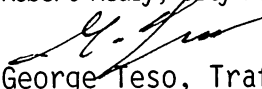

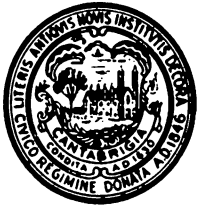
Subject City Council Order #35 dated 11-18-91 PParking for Volunteers of City Departments"

I have reviewed our policy toward parking for persons who volunteer to assist various city agencies and have determined that we should try to assist these volunteers to find parking spaces.

I am proposing that any person who volunteers their services to benefit the city could park in the Green-Franklin-Pearl Garage or the East Cambridge Parking Facility for one-half the cost of the regular rate. This would mean that the charge at the Green-Franklin-Pearl Facility would be \$.35/hr. and at the East Cambridge Facility it would be \$.50/hr.

The procedures that would be used are that each department that utilizes the services of these volunteers would submit the names of the person to the Traffic Director. The Director will then give the volunteer an identification card which upon showing it to the booth attendant would allow them to pay the half-rate charge.
