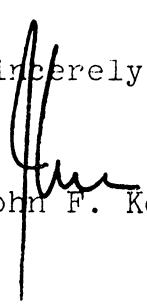
Dear Joe,

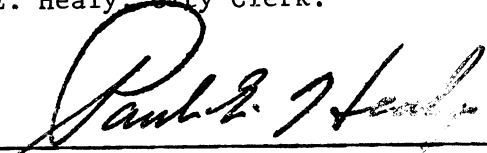
