During the summer the Community Development Department held two meetings concerning the proposed Mid Cambridge Neighborhood Conservation District. One meeting was a group of residents in favor of the Conservation District proposal and the other was a group of residents who voiced opposition to the proposal when it was presented at City Council in June. 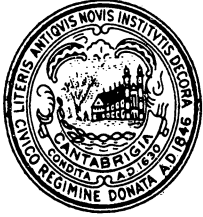

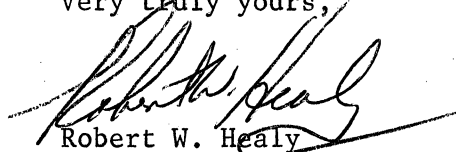
