



# City of Cambridge

IN CITY COUNCIL

January 28, 1974

**ORDERED:**

That the Commissioner of Public Works be and hereby is authorized to grant a permit to George B. H. Macomber Company of 89 Brighton Avenue, Boston to obstruct the sidewalks from the corner of Cambridge Street to a point 215 feet north on Roberts Road on the easterly side, and on the north side of Cambridge Street from the corner of Roberts Road easterly to a point approximately 147 feet to the east property line of 1611 Cambridge Street for a period of ten months commencing February 4, 1974 during the demolition of existing structure and the construction of a new building for the Harvard Community Health Plan, Cambridge Center.

Said permit to be granted subject to the following conditions:

1. A barricade constructed of chain-link fence eight feet high and a sturdy wooden construction with a roof for the protection of pedestrians who use this area during the period of demolition and construction to be erected in the public way suitably lighted as to prevent any injury to vehicles and pedestrians using this street.
2. Said obstruction to occupy the entire sidewalk and said barricade to occupy a distance of twenty-five feet of the public way from the curb line in such a manner to provide for the safe passage of pedestrians and vehicles and a minimum of twenty feet will be provided for the safe passage of vehicles in the two-way traffic system that currently exists on said street.
3. The contractor to restore existing sidewalk to the condition it was prior to the construction or to a better condition.
4. That no existing travel lanes shall be closed until authorized by the Director of Traffic and Parking.
5. That the contractor shall obtain a Temporary Street construction permit in addition to all other permits required by the City of Cambridge.
6. That the conditions having specified shall be subject to the approval of the Director of Traffic and Parking of the City of Cambridge, who may as he deems necessary require traffic controls or the use of policemen to facilitate the flow of traffic.
7. The contractor to file with the City Clerk a bond in the sum of \$10,000.00 indemnifying the City of Cambridge from any liability that may arise from the construction of said barricade during the period of construction.

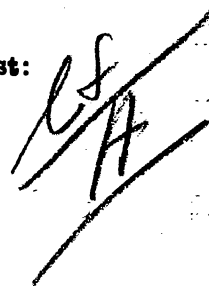
