WHEREAS:

"All men are created equal and are endowed by their Creator with certain inalienable rights among which are Life, Liberty, and the pursuit of happiness", and

WHEREAS:

The value of each person's life is determined not by what he or she does or produces but rather by the simple fact that the person is alive, and

WHEREAS:

The life of each person is sacred - the young and the old, the healthy and the sick, the gifted and the disadvantaged, and the life or rights of any single person cannot be violated, and

WHEREAS:

Only amendment of the Constitution of the United States of America can restore the respect and protection necessary to all human beings born and unborn, and

WHEREAS:

The principle that all human beings are entitled to life, liberty and the pursuit of happiness is hereby affirmed anew by us to be of ageless validity, now therefore be it

RESOLVED:

That in this year of the Bicentennial of this nation, the active support of all Americans is strongly recommended and urged for the passage of a Human Life Amendment to the Constitution of the United States of America to protect the Inalienable Right to Life of every human being, irrespective of age, health, function or condition of dependency.
