The driveway has been in continual use and I believe the only way to prevent cars from parking there is to remove the curb cut.

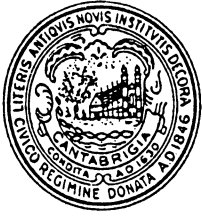
If there is any further action I should take to bring this about please let me know.

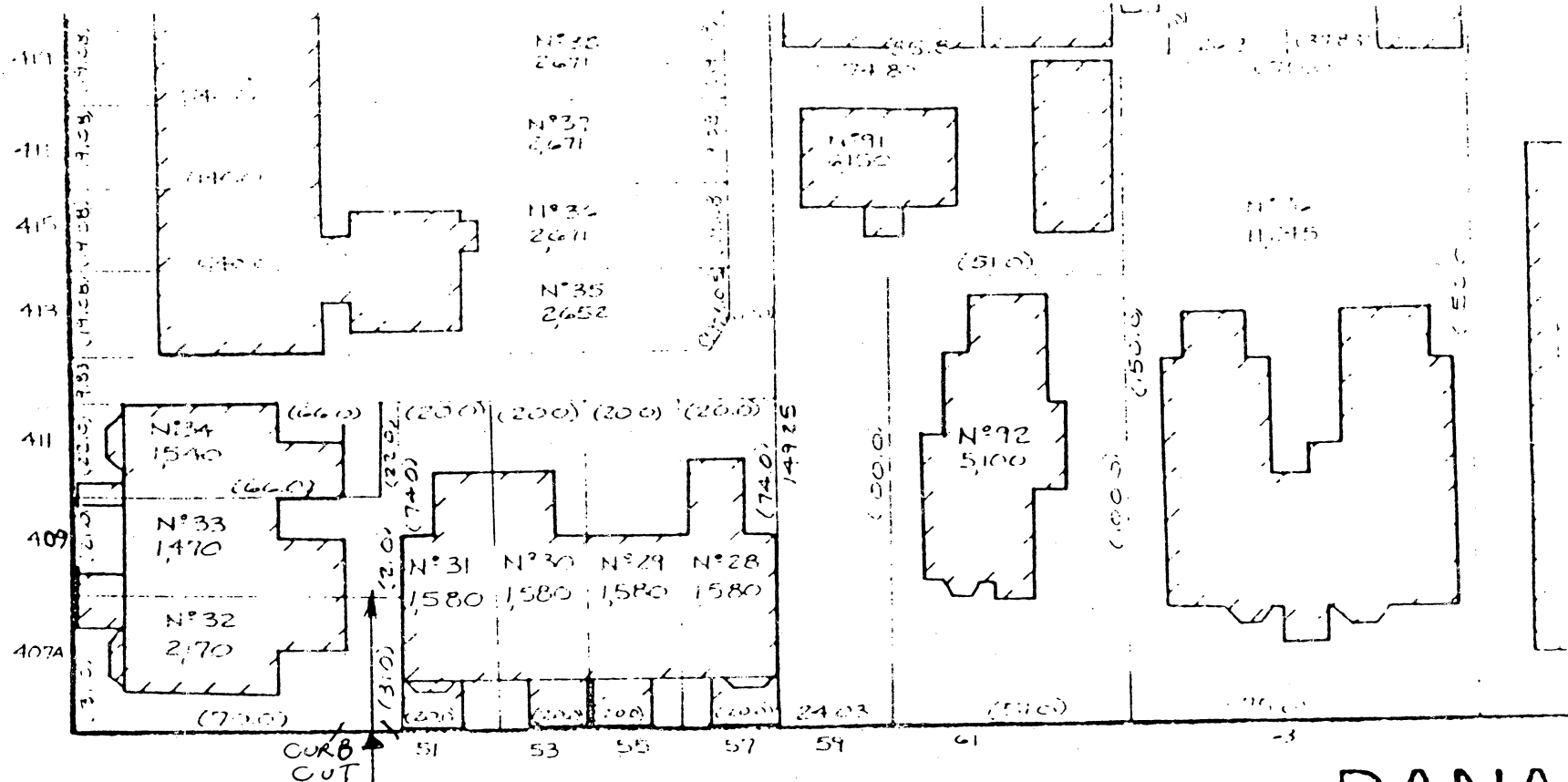

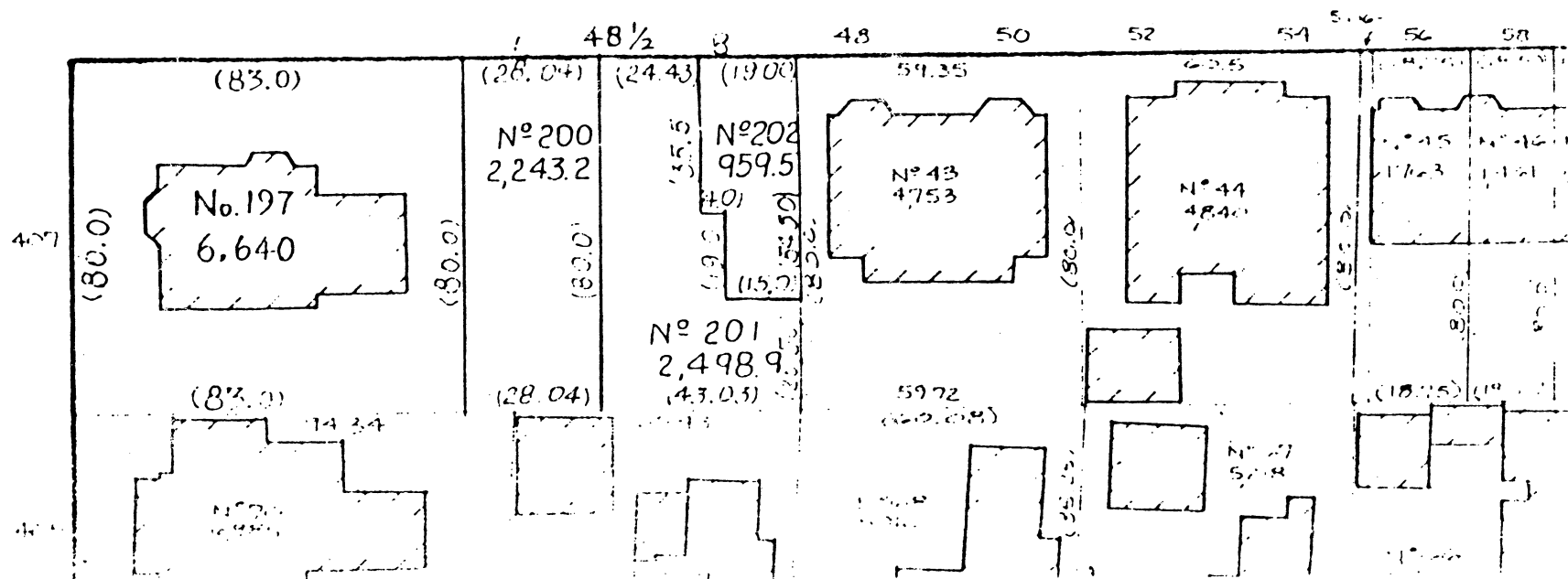
