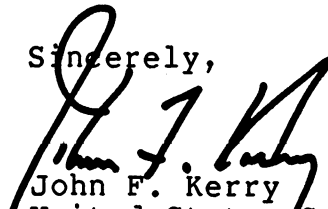
Dear Mayor Flynn:

Dear Friends:

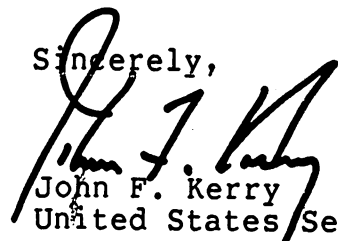
I am contacting you as a member of the Senate Foreign Relations Committee and as an individual concerned with human rights.

I have been contacted by a number of my constituents who have reported that Mayor of Port-au-Prince, Evans Paul's human rights have been violated. International cooperation relies heavily on a core of shared values, perhaps the most fundamental of which is basic human rights of the individual. The United Nations has recognized the importance of these values and has adopted its convention on human rights.

I would be very appreciative of any efforts you could make personally to see to it that Mayor Paul be treated according to the guidelines of this treaty. Only by recognizing the importance of each life can we begin to address the challenges of this decade and the next century.

Thank you for your attention to this pressing matter.
