2. The purposes for which the corporation is formed are as follows:

The corporation is organized exclusively for professional, educational and scientific purposes, said purposes to include the organization and execution of educational courses concerned with the administration of nursing homes and the proper instruction of personnel who work in nursing homes; the teaching of courses designed to help interested individuals prepare for the licensing examinations required of nursing home personnel; the organization of meetings among nursing home administrators and personnel to enhance the exchange of ideas and information concerning the programs and administration of nursing homes; and in general to promote the free exchange of ideas and information regarding health care for geriatric patients and others in need of specialized health care.

The corporation may engage in any other civic, educational or benevolent purpose permitted to corporations under General Laws Chapter 180, as now in effect or as hereafter amended, provided that in no event shall any part of the net earnings of the corporation inure to the benefit of or be distributable to its members, directors, officers, or other private persons. *

except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth above.

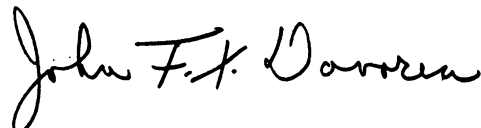
