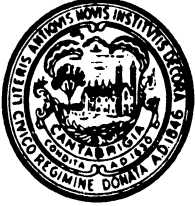

To The Honorable, The City Council:

I am hereby requesting an appropriation of \$100,000.00 in the Grant Fund of the Department of Human Services Salary and Wages Account (\$83,594.43), the Other Ordinary Maintenance Account (\$13,805.57) and the Travel and Training Account (\$2,600.00). The U. S. Department of Justice, Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention has awarded these funds to the Department of Human Services' Cambridge Prevention Coalition to provide alcohol, tobacco and other drug prevention training for Cambridge youth from October 1, 1999 to September 30, 2000. Funds will be used to cover a portion of the salaries of four full time staff as well as program operating costs.
