The Committee are of the opinion that the sidewalks in that portion of Raymond St near the residence of Henry A. Fuller &c are as good as the sidewalks in a large part of the City they therefore recommend that no action be taken upon that portion of said petition. The Committee would recommend that the speedy holes or watery places in said street be closed as in their opinion they are dangerous places and the City would be liable for any damage which might happen from said holes. The Committee recommend the adoption of the accompanying Order
