

City of Cambridge.

In Board of Aldermen, Sept. 29. 1868.

Whereas it is adjudged by the aldermen and Aldermen that the public necessity and convenience require that Elsey Street, so called, from Broadway to Cambridge Street, be laid out as a public highway, therefore

Ordered, That said Elsey Street be and lawfully is laid out and established as a public highway, by the name of Elsey Street, agreeably to a Plan thereof drawn by W. A. Cleaves, bearing date of March, 1869, and now on file in the office of the City Clerk, to wit from Broadway to Cambridge Street - the same to be forty feet in width, as delineated on said Plan.

Ordered, That no damages be awarded to the persons over whose land said Elsey Street is laid out as aforesaid.
