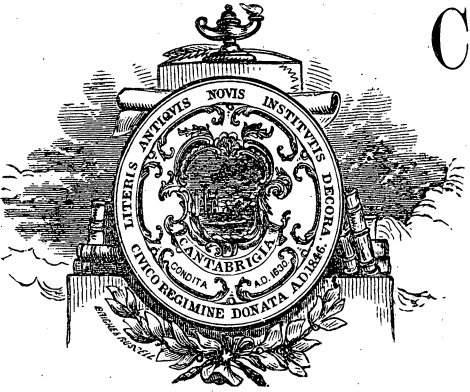




CITY OF CAMBRIDGE.

IN BOARD OF ALDERMEN,

Nov 12 1883.

WHEREAS: It is adjudged by this Board that the public necessity and convenience require that

Montgomery Street from Spruce Street,
to the northerly line of ^{land of} Maurice Heligan,

should be laid out as a public Street. Ordered that a strip of land

40 feet
in width between *said Spruce Street and*
said northerly line of ^{land of} Maurice Heligan

included between the *red* lines as shown on a plan drawn by *W.A. Mason*
and *Sam* and dated *Sept. 1883*

and now before this Board, be taken for public use and laid out as a public Street.

Ordered that *no* damages be allowed for the land so taken as aforesaid.
