- WHEREAS: Because of anticipated parking problems resulting from recently acquired city buildings on their street, Bigelow Street residents have been pressing to increase the availability of parking; and
- WHEREAS: In a November 16, 1987 communication, the City Manager informed the City Council among other things, that the Fire and Traffic Departments had no objection to removing the present Clinton Street ban on all-night parking; and
- WHEREAS: A recent Traffic Department survey of Clinton Street residents indicates that they are evenly divided on this issue, thus requiring the city to make a policy decision; therefore be it
- ORDERED: That the City Manager request the Traffic Director to allow all-night parking on Clinton Street as soon as possible.
