RESOLVED: That this City Council congratulates **ARLENE McGRADY** on her new position with the Council on Aging and wishes her the best of luck.

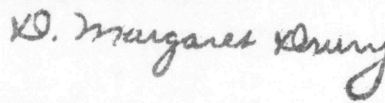
