- WHEREAS: This City Council was saddened upon learning of the death of Francis Carney, a former teacher in the Cambridge School System; and
- WHEREAS: Mr. Carney was a 1922 graduate of Boston College High School and a 1926 graduate of Boston College and two years after obtaining his Bachelors Degree, Francis entered the school system, teaching a variety of subjects including History and English at Cambridge High and Latin School; and
- WHEREAS: Francis worked his way up the career ladder of the School Department and rose to the position of Master, a position he held in three schools, Russell, Fletcher and the Roberts prior to his completion of forty-four years of public service, retiring in 1972; and
- WHEREAS: Mr. Carney was an active parish member of the Sacred Heart Church in Watertown, having served as President of the St. Vincent de Paul Society and as a member of the Holy Name Speakers Bureau; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its deep sympathy to Mrs. Catherine Carney and the entire family at this time of such personal loss; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Mrs. Carney on behalf of the entire City Council.
