I am submitting herewith fifteen copies of the revised ordinances of the City of Cambridge for presentation by you to the City Council for adoption.

The last revision of the City ordinances was in 1943. The revision submitted with this letter brings the general ordinances up to date as of December 31, 1970.

No substantive changes have been made except the total fine has been increased to fifty dollars which is the legal maximum at present. Conflicting, redundant and repealed ordinances have been eliminated.
