WHEREAS: This City Council was deeply saddened at learning of the death of Derek Lamb on November 5, 2005; and

WHEREAS: Derek was a internationally renowned Cambridge animator, filmmaker, and writer; and

WHEREAS: Derek began work as an animator in 1958 with the National Film Board of Canada. In 1964 he went to Harvard University, where he taught filmmaking and animation at the Carpenter Center for Visual Arts, and was a lecturer at Harvard in 1986 and 1990. Mr. Lamb produced programming for PBS and the Children's Television Workshop in the early to mid-1970's. Lamb returned to Montreal in 1976 to run the English animation studio for the national Film Board and over the next five years he produced 100 films, including two Academy Award-winning animated short films; and

WHEREAS: Derek's passing will leave a void in the lives of all his surviving family and friends, his wife Tracie Smart, his two sons Richard and Thomas, and his granddaughter; and

WHEREAS: Derek will be sorely missed by all he touched and loved; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its deepest sympathy to the family of Derek Lamb at this time of such personal loss; and be it further

RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to the Lamb family on behalf of the entire City Council.
