WHEREAS:

Some recent reports indicate that Harvard University may be seeking to enforce an agreement with the MBTA, requiring Harvard-Brattle station, currently the Red Line terminus, to close next spring, long before construction of the Red Line extension is complete; and

WHEREAS:

Such closing of the station could seriously disrupt Red Line operations and inconvenience passengers; therefore be it

ORDERED:

That the City Manager investigate this situation and report the facts to the City Council as soon as possible, together with his recommendations for resolving any problems that he finds.
