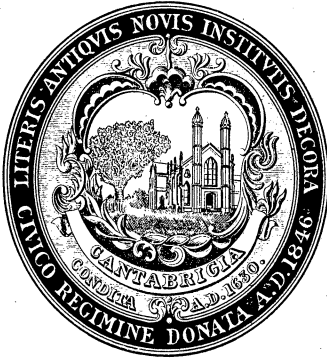

Honorable the City Council of the

City of Cambridge:—

I have received a copy of an order of the City Council passed at its meeting on October 31st, 1916, making formal application for a Carnegie donation for a library to be located in North Cambridge.

I think it would be well at the present time, and in accord with the views of the Library Trustees, to seek favorable consideration of a donation for a similar purpose to be used in East Cambridge. I am sure the consolidation of the branch libraries now located in the old police station on Fourth street and in the shelter on Cambridge Field into a Carnegie Library, would serve the public to advantage in this section of the City.

With funds in hand to construct a library in North Cambridge and East Cambridge, the need of a new library location would be provided for when Cambridge adopts the plan of a central police station.

In view of favorable action by your Board in establishing a central station, I respectfully recommend that the City Council pass another order making formal application for a Carnegie Library donation in accordance with the requirements of the
