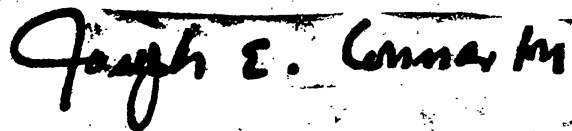

Subject: Funding for CRLS Air Quality Project:

The School Department has received a proposal (previously transmitted under separate cover) from Environmental Health Engineering, Inc. (E.H.E.) which details the services to be provided by E.H.E. and other experts in the field relating to the Air Quality Project at CRLS.

This proposal outlines the first major phase of the study of the ventilation systems and facility problem areas at CRLS. It will result in a report that analyzes the existing building ventilation systems, identifies problems, and recommends solutions. E.H.E. will be performing the bulk of this work, and will be overseeing the work of other experts in specialty areas as required.

The cost of this first phase of the work is projected not to exceed \$100,000. We request that this amount be allocated in a capital projects account to maintain separate and distinct control over expenditures related to this project.

As you are aware, E.H.E. has already initiated the investigation of the HVAC systems, while the Harvard School of Public Health group is undertaking the health risk assessment and health survey. We expect a report from E.H.E. by late June, with projected costs of recommended solutions. At that time we will need to determine additional funding requirements.

Thank you for your ongoing advice and assistance with this critical project.
