RE: Reconstruction & Resurfacing
of Line Street, Cambridge

Dear Mr. McElroy:

Please be advised that I am writing to you on behalf of myself and other residents of property located on Line Street.

The purpose of this letter is to inform you of the serious and deplorable condition of the road and sidewalk surfaces on Line Street. The present condition is not only unsightly, dangerous, and inconvenient, but is adversely affecting the value of our property. As you may know, the repairs which have been made over this street and sidewalk area in the past few years have been temporary at best, and have failed to permanently alleviate the situation. Passing over both the roadway and sidewalks is extremely inconvenient and in fact, a nuisance. We feel that the present serious state of the road and sidewalks will contribute to damage to motor vehicles, as well as personal injury to people walking along these surfaces.

We request you initiate whatever procedures are necessary for the reconstruction and resurfacing of this roadway. In addition, we would like to bring to your attention that Myrtle Avenue and Roberts Road, which are in the immediate neighborhood, have already been repaired and resurfaced and understand that Kirkland Street is scheduled to be repaired and resurfaced sometime this Spring. The City of Somerville has repaired and resurfaced two of the streets intersecting with Line Street, namely Smith Avenue and Cooney Street. You can see that Line Street is the only street presently in this neighborhood which requires your immediate attention.

I would appreciate your contacting myself as to what your intentions are concerning this matter, at your earliest possible convenience.
