

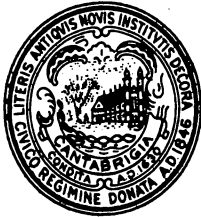



Enclosed for your approval is an appropriation order, in the amount of \$161,102., to restore to the Fire Department Salaries and Wages account that amount of the Anti-recession Fiscal Assistance that was received by the City for the last quarter of 1976-77.
