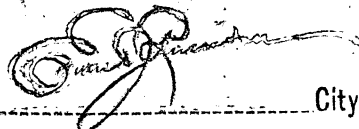
In City Council

ORDERED:

On the petition of Atwood and McManus Box Co. that permission be granted them to drain into the City sewer crossing their property on Aberdeen Avenue, at the old G. W. Gale Lumber Yard, Mt. Auburn, from premises not already assessed, provided that they first pay into the City Treasury the usual assessment amounting, in this case, to Three Hundred and Sixty-one Dollars and Ninety-two Cents (\$361.92).

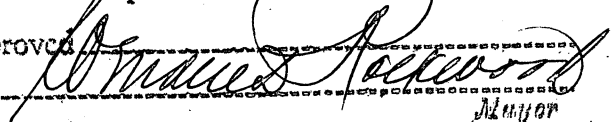
