IN CITY COUNCIL

June 25, 1984

- WHEREAS: City services should be provided to the public as conveniently as possible; and
- WHEREAS: Many people working a daytime job cannot get paid to see to City business, causing people to lose precious pay when they have to do business with the City; therefore be it
- ORDERED: That the City Manager prepare a program to keep City offices such as, but not limited to inspectional services, city clerk, election department, that serve the public functioning at least one evening a week and/or Saturday morning to provide services that citizens cannot obtain during the usual work week; and be it further
- ORDERED: That departments that serve the public seasonally as for payment of property taxes and for resident permit stickers maintain evening and/or Saturday hours during their busy season; and be it further
- ORDERED: That this program be implemented in the Fall and its scope reported to the City Council.

In City Council June 25, 1984.


