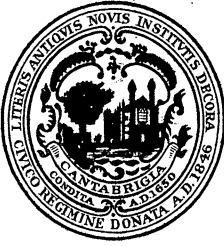

ORDERED

That a committee consisting of three members of this body, ^{as many} together with ^{as many} ~~one~~ ^{and the Superintendent of Public Bldgs.} members of the Board of Aldermen, be appointed to investigate the present condition and sufficiency of the fire escapes, and other means of egress in case of fire, of all buildings owned or occupied in whole or in part by the City, its officials, employees, or persons under its care, and within four weeks to render a report ~~to this body~~ stating the different buildings investigated, the date of ~~each~~ ^{the} investigation, the condition of each building, and, where such condition is not satisfactory, recommending alterations or additions.

The committee, with the approval of the Mayor, may, for not more than four weeks, hire offices and a stenographer to assist them in their investigation.
