

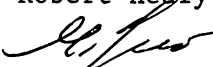

Subject City Council Order #18 of May 5, 1986 "Raymond St. Traffic"

We have made a study of the traffic on Raymond St., Bolton St. and Richdale Ave. and find that trucks are jumping the curb on Raymond St. to the one time extension of Bolton Street.

This is being done as a shortcut by vehicles entering Biotechnica International Inc. over property owned by the Walden Sq. Apartments. We talked to both parties and made suggestions on how they can stop this, even if we put barriers on Raymond St., there is a driveway that can be used for the same purpose. They both stated that they would take any action necessary and we stated that if they did not we would do whatever is necessary to stop these vehicles.
