WHEREAS: Michael played a major role in local AIDS prevention and treatment efforts and for the last two and a half years, worked on issues related to the HIV virus, AIDS and substance abuse; and

WHEREAS: Michael helped organize AIDS Awareness Week at Cambridge Rindge and Latin in 1989 and continued his prevention work at the high school, speaking at the AIDS Awareness Weeks in 1990 and 1991; and

WHEREAS: Michael worked for the Cambridge Hospital Multidisciplinary AIDS Program as a case manager for Drug Abuse and Health Care Services program in January 1990 and helped organize the acupuncture detoxification clinic and played a key role in developing a new position for a city substance abuse coordinator; and

WHEREAS: Michael's legacy is one filled of compassion, commitment and sharing to the Citizenry of Cambridge; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record expressing its deepest condolences to the family of Michael A. Razzino at this time of such personal loss; and be it further
