
Dear Mr. Healy:

On February 26th, 2002, the Cambridge Democratic City Committee met at the Cambridge Senior Center and selected our three candidates for Election Commissioner. In mid-December, members of our Executive Committee wrote a comprehensive questionnaire covering all important aspects of Election Commissioners' responsibilities. We publicized the opportunity for Democrats to submit questionnaires and enter the race, making an announcement at the Democratic City Committee meeting on December 4th, 2001, and placing an advertisement in *The Cambridge Chronicle*. Only one candidate, Lynne Molnar of 181 Harvey Street, submitted a questionnaire by the deadline. Subsequently, the city committee convened a hearing, of which notice was provided to all city committee members, at the North Cambridge Senior Center on the evening of February 7th, 2002. At this hearing – which was attended by a majority of the city committee's officers and by the other Democratic election commissioner – Ms. Molnar thoughtfully answered questions for about an hour and a half.

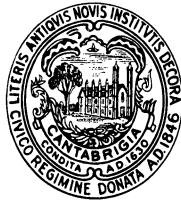
At our meeting on February 26th, we nominated our three commissioners. As required by our bylaws, we placed Ms. Molnar's name in nomination, and she was approved as our first choice by acclamation. Our second and third choices, George Goverman of 1643 Cambridge Street and Sonia Kastner of Quincy House, were also approved by acclamation.
