ORDERED: That this City Council go on record favoring the enactment of the following amendment to the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Cambridge: Article 7.000 Signs and Illumination is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof a new section 7.18 which reads as follows:

Political signs shall be exempt from the requirements of Article 7.000, Sections 7.12, 7.13 and 7.14 for a period commencing thirty (30) days before and seven (7) days following a primary or general election.

and be it further

ORDERED: That the City Clerk transmit this proposed amendment to the Planning Board and the Ordinance Committee for hearing and report in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 40A of the General Laws and amendments thereto.

Notice of a Public Hearing

The Planning Board of the City of Cambridge will hold a public hearing on Tuesday, November 13, 1979 at 7:30 p.m. in the Community Development Department Conference Room, third floor, City Hall Annex, Cambridge, MA. The purpose of the hearing will be to consider a petition by the Planning Board to amend the zoning ordinance of the City of Cambridge by changing the filing fee for Special Permits from fifty dollars to seventy five dollars as specified in sections 10.21 and 10.42. The petition would also require a filing fee of one hundred dollars each for submittal of development proposals and final development plans, for Special Permits to construct Planned Unit Development as specified in section 12.344 and 12.362. The amount of all such filing fees are used to pay expenses incident to advertising of the required public hearings.

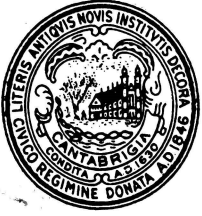


