Cambridge Hospital from March 21-25, 1978.

my room. The Security guard then took
the basket, and said he would see to it
that it was delivered. I never received

Detective Flemming, head of Security. Det.
Flemming made a complete investigation,
and found the Hospital, to be completely
responsible for the loss, and advised me
that I would obtain full restitution, by
filing this complaint.
