And it is

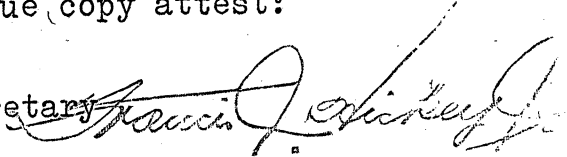
