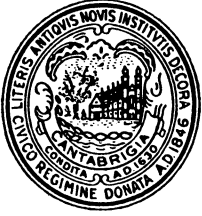

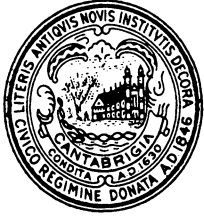
These transfers are necessary to maintain the efficiency of the Department.

The transfer to A-2-Temporary Employees is necessary to pay summer help for night-time painting, cleaning parking lots and to pay temporary help filling permanent positions. The transfer to B-1-Printing is necessary to pay the balance of bills incurred in the printing of new traffic regulation booklets. The transfer to B-22-Medical is to pay invoices due Somerville Hospital for treatment of John Gargano invoice approved by the City Solicitor. The transfer to B-39-Services not otherwise coded is to replace \$300.00 expended to cover the Traffic Director's expenses at Dynamic Design Safety Seminar April 2, to 6, 1972 at Hartford, Conn. The transfer to B-44-Travel outside the State is to cover expenses to the Annual Convention of the Institute of Traffic Engineers to be held in New York City, Sept. 24-28, 1972, to be attended by the Traffic Director. The transfer to D-6-Library is to purchase text books dealing with traffic and planning from the Library of Urban Affairs.


