The general public has a right to expect honest and fair treatment from inspectors charged with the responsibility of protecting the health and safety of the citizens of Cambridge, therefore be it

RESOLVED:

That the Cambridge City Council requests the City Manager to conduct a comprehensive investigation of the charges made by The Real Paper and report his findings to the City Council as soon as possible.
