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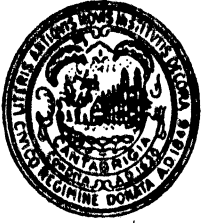

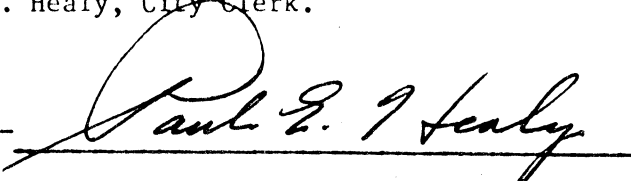
RESOLVED:

That the City of Cambridge, Massachusetts, U.S.A., hereby resolves to request the appropriate officials of El Salvador to make public the reasons for the arrest of David Elias Guadron Valencia, Pedro Ramirez Esquivel, Pablo Ramirez Cornejo, Raul Antonio Castro Palomares, Vicente Ortiz, Carlos Menjivar, Hector Fernandez, Daniel (or David) Avalos, and Berta Alicia Castro, and to advise whether the rights of these persons are being observed under the United National Universal Declaration of Human Rights. As elected government officials in a democratic society, the Cambridge City Councillors wish to say to El Salvadorian officials that political activity should never result in the violation of a person's liberty, and further that disregard of the personal rights of members of political opposition creates a destabilizing force in the world.

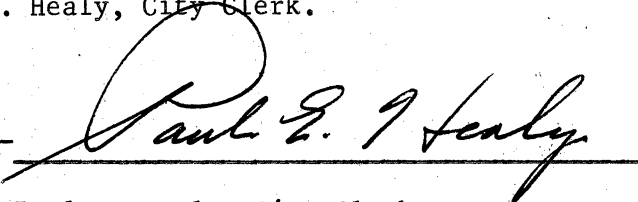
