WHEREAS: The Vermont Department of Agriculture is donating two large Balsam Fir trees to Cambridge - one to mark the beginning of the procession in Harvard Square, one to stand at Charles Square for the lighting ceremony; and

WHEREAS: The Vermont Ski Association is donating three-to-six week-long ski vacations to ski areas in Vermont, including Sugarbush, Killington, Pico, as raffle prizes for those who enter a special drawing in Cambridge during the holiday season; and

WHEREAS: The Vermont Department of Agriculture is donating Vermont-made products, including apples, coffee and maple syrup, for consumption by the public throughout the holiday season in Cambridge; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That this City Council, as a way of saying thank you for the good will being generated by the State of Vermont on behalf of the City of Cambridge during the holiday season, proclaim Friday, November 27, 1987 to be "A Vermont Holiday Celebration Day"; and be it further

RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to prepare a duly engrossed copy of this Resolution for presentation and display.
