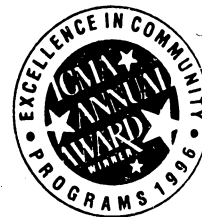
I have instructed Officer Long to contact all the traffic supervisors both personally and in writing with instructions regarding the proper procedures for crossing children at signalized locations.
