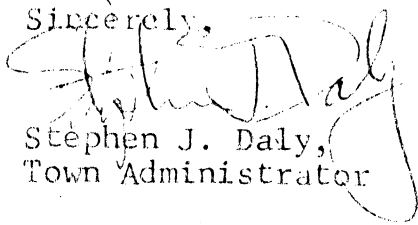
The Board of Selectmen has reviewed the MAPC's "Minuteman Commuter Bikeway Study" and we fully support this worthwhile project. In addition to providing an attractive route for cyclists who commute daily from our Town to Cambridge and Boston, the facility could be important in reducing automobile congestion on State Routes 4/225 and 62, by providing an attractive transportation alternative to many who commute daily to Bedford's industries.

The Selectmen are very concerned, however, about the Millbrook Valley sewer in conjunction with the establishment of the bikeway. It would be unfortunate if the timing of either were to jeopardize the successful completion of both projects.

We have noted the projected annual expense of maintaining Bedford's segment of the bikeway, and feel confident that the Town would support these costs.

We request that the Minuteman Commuter Bikeway be included in your Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) list and be considered for funding under the Bikeway Bond Program.
