In Board of Aldermen, June 10 1885

Ordered,

The Committee on Roads and Bridges to which was referred the petition of Samuel Nash, representing that he purchased certain filling material to be taken from land on Rockingham Street, which material was afterwards sold to the city, - and asking that the city relinquish its claim to a portion of the said material,

Reports

That said filling material was purchased by this Committee for filling the Mill Pond basin. The said material was bought to be measured in the bank, and the petitioner commenced taking it away before the same was measured.

Inasmuch as the measurement will fall far short of the quantity of material which the bank was supposed to contain, there will ^{be} none to spare from the Mill-Pond filling. Your Committee therefore recommend that the petitioner have leave to withdraw.
