- WHEREAS: Many of the elevators in senior housing are not equipped with telephones which could be used in the event of an emergency; and
- WHEREAS: The alarm bells are not always heard by occupants of the buildings when they are rung, especially in late evening hours, and
- WHEREAS: A recent incident occurred in one of our elderly housing buildings where one of the residents was trapped in the elevator, ringing the emergency bell to no avail; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That the City Manager confer with the members of the Housing Authority with the view in mind of installing emergency telephones in the elevators of elderly housing buildings where there are none presently installed.
