Mr Tiffield,

Sir - In compliance with your request, I have made an examination of Prison Point Bridge. I find it in a very dangerous condition, some of the Piers have settled from six to fifteen inches, some of the piles washed away, and I think it would be a waste of money to repair the same.

I have made an Estimate of the Cost, to build a Bridge, the same Width of the present one, with Spruce Piles, Girders, and Braces, the Superstructure to be the same as River St. Bridge, will cost Fourteen Dollars Thirty-four cents (\$14.34) per lineal foot,
