To The Honorable, The City Council:

I am hereby requesting the appropriation of \$8,754.00 into the Grant Fund of the Department of Human Services Salary and Wages Account (\$7,121.00) and Other Ordinary Maintenance Account (\$1,633.00) from Employment Resources Incorporated. The Community Learning Center has been awarded additional funds to add a summer session to the Adult Career Pathways Program and to participate in the development of curriculum frameworks. The Learning Center will be able to serve ten new students in a ten week intensive summer program where students will attend classes and transition to enter the job market or qualify for further training. These funds will be used for teacher salaries and benefits and educational supplies and resources.
