On May 3, 1976 this City Council unanimously adopted an order requesting the City Manager to direct the Planning Board and the Community Development Department to prepare the required applications for funding by federal and state agencies concerned with developing a shopping mall in the area bounded by Huron Avenue, Chilton Street, Standish Street and Lakeview Avenue, and

This program was to have included the installation of new sidewalks, tree plantings, hanging gardens and revised parking alignments for this neighborhood, and

The original council request has apparently fallen on "deaf ears", in so far as absolutely no response has been received from either the City Manager or the Community Development Department, now therefore be it

That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to report back to this City Council within one week the action taken by him pursuant to this order.
