- WHEREAS: It has come to the attention of this City Council that Sister Mary Timothy Calnan S.N.D. (sister of the late David I. Calnan, former World War II hero) will celebrate her 50th anniversary of entering the convent; and
- WHEREAS: During her 50 years as a religious, Sister Mary Timothy has served in several schools in both the Archdiocese of Boston and the Diocese of Springfield, teaching in St. Mark's School, Dorchester; Sts. Peter and Paul, South Boston; St. John's, Peabody; St. Bernard's, West Newton; Holy Nanse in Chicopee; St. Mary's as principal in Danvers; and St. Mary's and Blessed Sacrament; and
- WHEREAS: Sister Mary Timothy has been implementing the Development in Reading Efficiency Program for the Cambridge School Department for the past several years, a program in which she is considered an authority, having lectured extensively on the subject throughout Massachusetts as well as being a consultant in field for several years; and
- WHEREAS: Sister Mary Timothy retired from active teaching in 1979 but has continued her religious ministry by doing social work with the elderly of Blessed Sacrament Parish, particularly at the L.B.J. Elderly Apartment complex; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending our sincere congratulations to Sister Mary Timothy Calnan S.N.D. as she celebrates her Golden Jubilee with a Mass of Thanksgiving on Sunday, May 18, 1980 at 2 p.m. at the Blessed Sacrament Church; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to prepare for presentation a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution for Sister Mary Timothy on behalf of the entire City Council.
