Dear Bob:

At the request of Mayor Ackerman and of City Manager John Corcoran, I called you on Wednesday, June 20, 1973 regarding our F-7 Non-Contributory Pension Account.

If you recall on a previous occasion, I had mentioned to you the fact that during our budget hearings, Mayor Ackerman stated that the City Manager would place money in his budget to cover our F-7 account from July 1, 1973 through June 30, 1974, and for that reason the School Department F-7 budget account only shows enough money to cover the period January 1, 1973 through June 30, 1973.

Confirming our conversation on this matter, it is my understanding that the City Manager will place in his Miscellaneous Pension Budget Account, a total of \$483,358.00 to cover the cost of the Non-Contributory Pensions of School Department employees for the period from July 1, 1973 through June 30, 1974.

To the Honorable, the City Council:

Your favorable consideration of an additional appropriation in the sum of \$483,358.00 to the Miscellaneous - Non-Contributory Pensions account, listed on Page 43 of the Budget, is respectfully requested.

Up until this budget cycle the responsibility for administering the so-called non-contributory pensions rested in our various and several departments. I have tried to consolidate this activity in the Retirement Board office where it properly belongs. The changeover date will be July 1, 1973.

When the budget was prepared and originally submitted it inadvertently failed to provide sufficient funds for the School Department retired non-contributory employees. I therefore request favorable consideration of the enclosed appropriation request of \$483,358.00 to Miscellaneous - Non-Contributory Pensions, said sum to be included in and made part of the 1973 Tax Levy, in order that the retired employees of the School Department in the non-contributory system will continue to be paid.
