

City of Cambridge.

In Board of Aldermen, June 26. 1888

Ordered,

That the Superintendent of Streets, be directed to set Edge-stones upon the sidewalks upon the Streets hereinafter named. The expense thereof to be charged to the appropriation for Street Department (Paving.) The cost of materials furnished to be assessed upon the abutters in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 191 of the acts of the year 1863.

Edge-stones,

- ✓ On Banks Street, westerly side from Cooperthwaite St. to Flagg Street,
- ✓ On Ellsworth Avenue, ^{North} westerly side from Broadway, north-easterly to north-east line of estate of John Rider,
- ✓ On Howard Street, south-westerly side from Prospect of Essex Street,
- ✓ On Webster Avenue, ^{easterly side} from nos 105 to 113, inclusive.
- ✓ On Western Avenue, westerly side, from Howard Street westerly about two hundred feet,

Circles and Return Stones,

- ✓ On the westerly corner of Banks and Flagg Streets,
- ✓ On the southerly and westerly corners of Charles River and Mill Streets,
