WHEREAS: The residents of Meacham Road in Cambridge have submitted a petition to the Commissioner of Traffic and Parking to have Meacham Road become a one-way street; and

WHEREAS: Meacham Road has experienced excessive use due to traffic attempting to circumvent the signals at Massachusetts Avenue and Day Street, and the residents are therefore concerned with the danger this presents to the residents; now therefore be it

ORDERED: That the City Manager instruct the Commissioner of Traffic and Parking to begin a formal survey of the residents of Meacham Road to determine the possibility of making Meacham Road a one-way street; and be it further

ORDERED: That the Commissioner of Traffic and Parking inform the Council of the developments in this matter periodically.

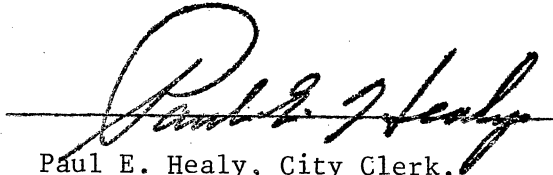
