WHEREAS: The City Council understands the sensitive nature of sexual attacks and deeply respects the privacy of all victims of these heinous crimes; and

WHEREAS: Prevention of all such attacks is of course the ultimate goal of this City Council; and

WHEREAS: This City believes that a process which would both protect the privacy rights of individual victims, but also foster public awareness of these crimes and lead citizens and patrol officers alike to work together and take every possible precaution to prevent all such attacks; and

WHEREAS: This City Council is aware that the Police Department has recently worked with neighborhood groups and the Cambridge Women's Commission in an effort to bring about a better public awareness of these crimes while protecting the sensitive rights of victims; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to confer with the Police Commissioner and provide the City Council with a detailed plan (within 30 days) of how the Police Department provides the public with information of these sexual attacks and any other information relative to the Police Department's efforts to prevent all future attacks of this nature.

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
