ORDERED: That the intersection of Western Avenue and Hews Street be designated as " Phil Penezick Square " in tribute to the memory of the late Phil Penezick, a neighborhood institution who, for 40 years as proprietor of Phil's Variety at 283 Western Avenue, was affectionately known as " Uncle Phil " by generations of children in the Riverside-Cambridgeport neighborhoods. A generous neighbor, compassionate friend, a person who shared the concerns of many without regard for color, creed or place of origin, he showed his belief that in the marathon of life, there is to be one winner, the human race, as each of its members confronts the content of each day; and be it further

ORDERED: That the City Manager direct the appropriate departmental personnel to begin preparation of the sign which will so designate the intersection in order that an appropriate ceremony of dedication can be carried out as soon as possible.
