Background

We all work in Cambridge and live in the Inman Square area. We will be riding from New York to Boston with the Northeast AIDS Ride 2002. We have been training together all Spring, and must raise \$8500 in order to make the June ride together. We have raised about half of this amount so far.

Proposal

We have talked to Mark LaHoud, manager of 1369 Coffeehouse in Central Square, about helping us out with the fundraising. Mark has generously agreed to allow us to ride a stationary bicycle outside the Central Square café. Our plan is to bike in place and to talk to people about our training efforts and about HIV/AIDS. (Two of our members—Maisha and Kristen—have experience as sexuality and health educators, as both have been directors of the “Know Your Body” program in the Cambridge Public Schools’ fifth- and eight-grade curriculum.)

Team Sojourner is asking for permission to:

- 1) Display a small sign (a simple 20” x 20” signboard). The sign would include information about HIV/AIDS and explain to people why Team Sojourner members have been training so hard to make the four-day, 350-mile ride on June 20 – 23, 2002.
- 2) Solicit donations on behalf of the Northeast AIDS Ride. A \$10 donation would entitle a donor to a small cup of coffee & will get them a raffle ticket. The stationary bicycle upon which we will be riding has been donated by Quadcycles of Arlington. We will raffle off the bike at the end of the day. We will keep strict accounts of donations through the raffle system, since registering for the raffle will require the donor to record their name and phone numbers. *All the money will go to charity, including Fenway Community Health in Boston.*
- 3) Set up a stationary bicycle beside the tables already outside 1369 Coffeehouse, and to ride in place on Saturday, June 15th, 2002.

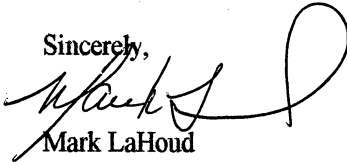

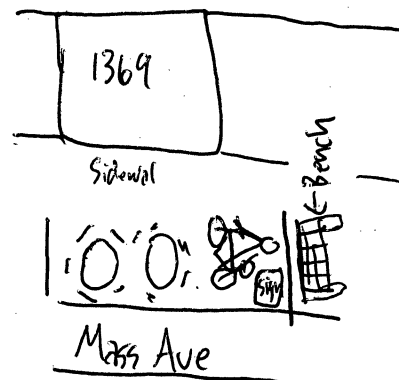
